Purpose

- ☐ To evaluate the effectiveness of the LEND and DBP Training programs in meeting the goals and objectives of the Combating Autism Act Initiative.
- We are conducting independent evaluations of these two training programs, as well as 2 other CAAI grant programs (Research Networks and State Implementation Grants).

Overview of Methodology

- Quantitative Data Collection
 - NIRS new module
 - □ LEND: Grantees awarded CAAI funds in FY 09 were asked to report in July 09; all grantees are asked to report in July and December 2010.
 - □ DBP: the 6 programs awarded CAAI funds in FY 09 were asked to report in July 09; they are also asked to report in July and December 2010.
 - Additional quantitative data may be obtained from the EHB.

Overview of Methodology

- Qualitative Data Collection
 - Continuing Applications
 - In-depth interviews
 - □ LEND: 22 grantees were interviewed in December 2009 or January/February 2010; all will be interviewed in December 2010.
 - □ DBP: 6 CAAI grantees awarded CAAI funds in FY 09 were interviewed in December 09/January 2010. They will be interviewed again in March 2011.
