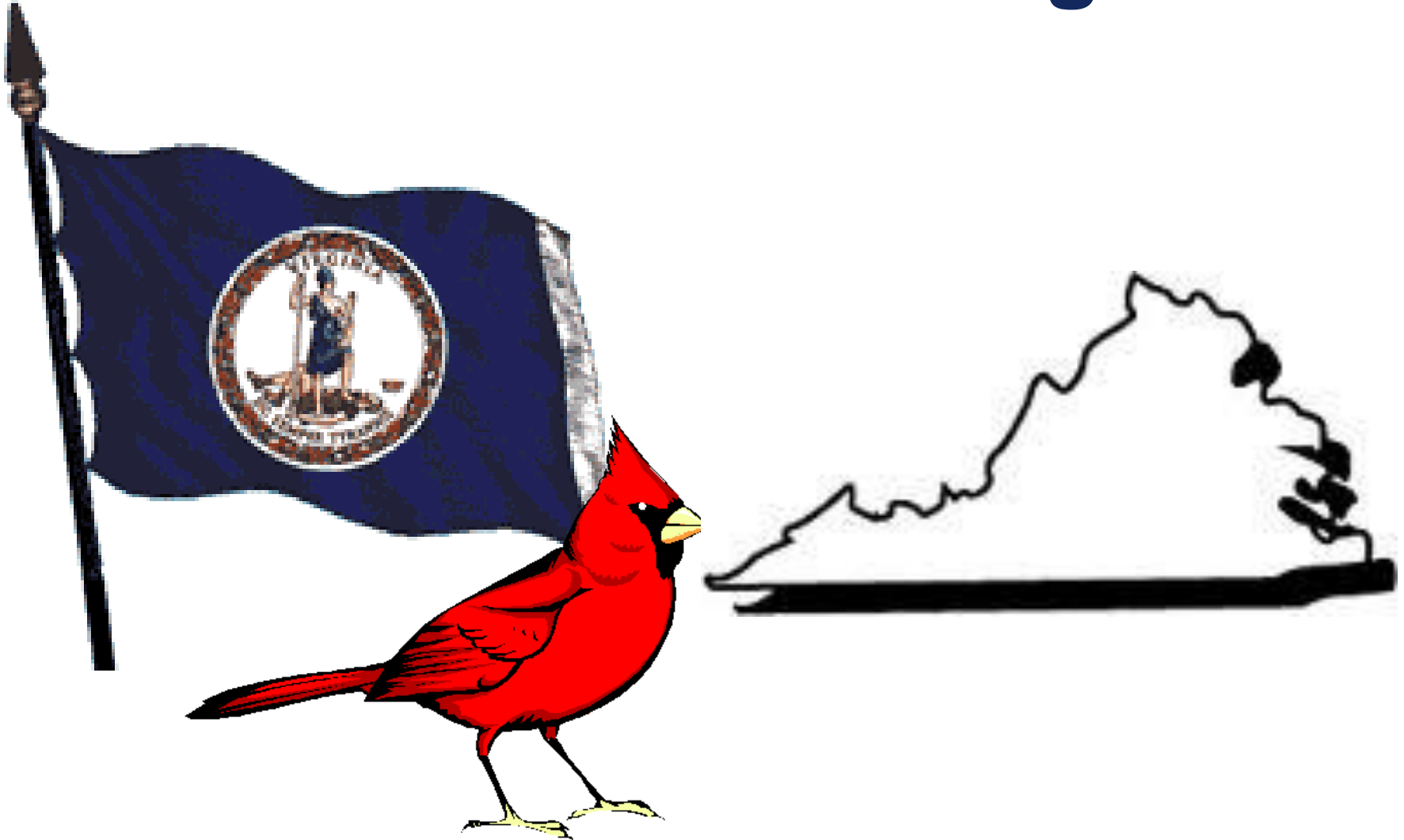

VIRGINIA STATE TEAM PLANNING CONTEXT:

VAULT is new non-profit cross-disability organization.

9 separate state self-advocacy organizations are involved in VAULT, but not all 9 are represented on VA state team for this summit.

Some organizations represented at this summit are not part of VAULT.

The state team talked a lot about how to identify goals that were not just VAULT goals, but can use the energy of VAULT.

Goal #1: Develop communication among various self-advocacy (SA) groups/organizations

HOW?	WHO?	WHEN?
Identify different SA groups and what they do	- UCEDD already has a map on its website, but Jack needs updates (VirginiaSelfAdvocacy.org*)	<u>May 15:</u> Jack will send map to attendees
	- Ann to send info on other/more radical SA groups (Icarus, Mind Free), which have chapters in VA	<u>June 6:</u> Ann to send info
	- Autism groups: ASA (Autism Society of America) can contribute information on their state chapter	<u>July:</u> Shawn to send info
	- Aisha: send NYLN info and help open lines of communication between state and national	<u>August (tentative):</u> Aisha - NYLN info
Gather info to identify if CSB and providers support SA group (data collection can occur via a simple survey)	UCEDD with help of Office of Developmental Disabilities (ODD)	May 15: Survey is already developed; waiting to implement

Goal #3: Build a coalition (Lee to help name this coalition, if invited by self-advocates; perhaps use VAULT structure)

Goal #4: Identify topics of interest for policy impact by coalition
