3 BIG LOSSES DUE TO CUTS:


<u>Tailor these examples for your</u> organization

- 5,000 infants identified with hearing loss each year, but even fewer now receiving life-changing care
- 6.4M children with ADHD, but less CDC support to states providing behavioral treatment
- 54M people with disabilities, but fewer connected with health programs that work

REAL: Disabilities are associated with \$400 billion in healthcare costs each year

RIGHT NOW: 1 in 5 Americans has a disability— anyone can acquire a disability at any time

RISKY: People with disabilities are at increased risk for early death because of preventable differences in the burden of disease, injury, and health opportunities
