## 1. TRAINEES DATASET

### 1.1. Primary Language

This is a new section that has been added to the trainee main record, and it is required for all Programs. Below are the questions in this section.

### 1.2. Personal relationship with Disabilities

This field from the main trainee record has been modified:

- It is now required for all Programs.
- “Unrecorded” had been added to the list of options.

### 1.3. Add Short Term Trainee button

Short Term Trainees (and all the relevant options) used to be located at the bottom of the Trainee List/Edit page, making it inconvenient sometimes to add a Short Term Trainee record. A new button has been added to the top of the Trainee List/Edit page: Add Short Term Trainee. Clicking this button will open up the Short Term Trainee form, which has not been modified in any way, so it can be completed and saved as usual.

### 1.4. View Short Term Trainees button

Short Term Trainees (and all the relevant options) used to be located at the bottom of the Trainee List/Edit page, making it inconvenient sometimes to view Short Term Trainee records. A new button has been added to the top of the Trainee List/Edit page: View Short Term Trainees. Clicking this button will take the user directly to the list of Short Term Trainees.

### 1.5. Report title change

To match the Performance Measure in the EHB, a Standard Report in the LEND, LEAH, PPC, DBP column has been renamed from PM A: Working with MCHB Populations at 5 Years Post Training to PM 84: Working with MCHB Populations at 5 Years Post Training.

## 3. ACTIVITIES DATASET

### 3.1. Activity forms have been customized per Core Function and Program Type

To better accommodate the data entry needs of all Programs that use NIRS, Activity data entry forms have been customized: when adding a new Activity record, the user must now first select the Core Function, then the Program Type, and based on the choices made, the Add Activity form will open up with only the relevant fields to complete. This will eliminate the need to complete fields not required for an Activity's Program Type, or keeping track of what fields to complete for each Core function.

### 3.2. Changing the Activity Core Function

If an Activity is accidentally added with the incorrect Core Function, then it is very easy to fix it:

- Search for the respective Activity
- Click on the View button to its left
- From the New Core Focus drop-down menu, select the correct Core Function
- Click on Save As just beneath the drop-down menu
- The Activity form opens up with the appropriate fields for the newly selected Core Function. All fields that applied to the initial Core Function as well, are pre-filled with data previously entered. Complete all the required fields for the current Core Function and save the record.
- Search the original Activity, with the incorrect Core Function, and delete it – this does not happen automatically.

### 3.3. Core Functions

Some Core functions have been renamed and/or redefined, based on the latest [UCEDD Logic Model](#). Following are the titles and definitions applicable starting FY 2013.

#### I. Interdisciplinary Pre-Service Preparation (Training Trainees)

UCEDDs: Instructional program offered by the UCEDD that: (1) integrates knowledge and methods from two or more distinct disciplines; (2) integrates direct contributions to

the field made by people with disabilities and family members; (3) examines and advances professional practice, scholarship and policy that impacts the lives of people with developmental and other disabilities and their families; (4) is designed to advance an individual's academic or professional credentials; and (5) takes place in an academic setting or program.

It may: (1) lead to the award of an initial academic degree, professional certificate, or advanced academic credential; and (2) contribute to a discipline-specific course of study offered by the UCEDD or by another academic department.

LENDs, LEAHs, PPCs, DBPs: You may use this to track training activities for long, medium or short-term trainees.

## II. **Continuing Education/Community Training** (formerly under Performing Technical Assistance and/or Training, sub-category Training)

UCEDDs: Continuing Education: Seminar(s) or courses of instruction offered by a UCEDD that: (1) serve to maintain professional credentials; (2) encourage professionals to expand their knowledge base and stay up-to-date on new developments; and (3) offer certificates of completion or CEUs (or their equivalents).

Training: Training provided by UCEDD faculty/staff to enhance knowledge of a variety of community members (individuals with developmental and other disabilities, their families, professionals, paraprofessionals, policy-makers, students or others in the community).

Activities will be categorized as Continuing Education or Community Training based on the response to the question "Are continuing education credits offered? ", which already exists in NIRS:

- Yes = Continuing Education
- No = Community Training

LENDs, LEAHs, PPCs, DBPs: Use this for tracking CE activities needed to complete the Continuing Education Form and PM #59. Continuing Education is defined as continuing education programs or trainings that serve to enhance the knowledge and/or maintain the credentials and licensure of professional providers. Training may also serve to enhance the knowledge base of community outreach workers, families, and other members who directly serve the community.

## III. **Technical Assistance** (formerly under Performing Technical Assistance and/or Training, sub-category Technical Assistance)

UCEDDs: Direct problem-solving services provided by UCEDD faculty/staff to assist individuals with developmental and other disabilities, families, programs, agencies, or other entities in improving their outcomes, services, management, and/or policies.

Examples of improvements include, but are not limited to:

- Enhanced resources
- Enhanced services
- Strengthened networking of public and private entities across communities

- Increased awareness of evidence-based practices
- Enhanced capacity to assess current practices in relation to evidence-based approaches
- Identification of policy changes needed within the area of emphasis

LENDs, LEAHs, PPCs, DBPs: use this for tracking TA activities needed to complete the Technical Assistance/Collaboration Form and PM #59. Technical Assistance/Collaboration refers to mutual problem solving and collaboration on a range of issues, which may include program development, clinical services, collaboration, program evaluation, needs assessment, and policy & guidelines formulation. It may include administrative services, site visitation and review/advisory functions. Collaborative partners might include State or local health agencies, and education or social service agencies. Faculty may serve on advisory boards to develop &/or review policies at the local, State, regional, national or international levels. The technical assistance (TA) effort may be a one-time or on-going activity of brief or extended frequency.

**IV. Direct Clinical Services/Model Services** (formerly under Performing Direct and/or Demonstration Services, Model Services added)

UCEDDs: Specialized clinical services delivered with the intention to enhance the well-being and status of the recipient and not for testing new practices and may be integrated with training, research, and/or dissemination functions.

LENDs, LEAHs, PPCs, DBPs: may be used for tracking Direct Health Care Services.

**V. Other Direct Services/Model Services**(formerly under Performing Direct and/or Demonstration Services, Model Services added)

All Programs: Specialized non-clinical services delivered with the intention to enhance the well-being and status of the recipient and not for testing new practices and may be integrated with training, research, and/or dissemination functions.

**VI. Demonstration Services** (formerly under Performing Direct and/or Demonstration Services)

All Programs: Services that field test promising or exemplary practices and may be integrated with training, research, and/or dissemination functions.

**VII. Performing Research or Evaluation** (no changes)

All Programs: Implementation of basic and applied research, program evaluation, and analysis of public policy on issues impacting individuals with developmental disabilities.

**VIII. Information Dissemination** (just a title change)

All Programs: Distribution of knowledge-based information through UCEDD developed products and activities.

### 3.4. Types and Numbers of Participants

The list of options has been updated:

- Other Classroom Students (new)
- Professionals & Para-Professionals
- Family Members/Caregivers

- Children/Adolescents with Disabilities/SHCN

Additionally, for option Trainees, the breakdown of Disciplines is no longer available for all Core Functions, but only for Interdisciplinary Preservice Preparation (Training Trainees) and Continuing Education/Community Training, and only for UCEDDs. For all other Core Functions and for MCHB Training Programs, the number of trainees can simply be entered in the Trainees line, without having to provide the Discipline breakdown.

### 3.5. **Initial Outcome Measure**

This field is new, and it is very similar to the Customer Satisfaction Measure, but the statements differ. This field is required only for UCEDD Programs, but it includes the “Not Applicable” option for Activities to which it does not apply. Below are the statements for each Core Function.

**3.7. Agencies Collaborating on the Work of the Activity/Recipient of TA**

The list of options (select all that apply) has been extended, and it now is identical to the list in the Projects dataset. For Activities, a Primary Recipient of TA or Collaborator must now be selected, and then other Agencies can be selected separately. The Primary Recipient of TA has been added for MCHB Training Programs, and the field is required only for them. The reason for this change is so that MCHB Programs can enter their TA/Collaboration Activities in the Activities dataset, instead of the Projects one. Based on feedback from MCHB Programs, and after a careful review of the MCHB reporting requirements, it was decided that this would better accommodate the data entry and reporting needs of MCHB Programs. In addition to modifying the Activity form, the TA/Collaboration report will also be added to the Standard Report in the Activities dataset to serve for completing the TA/Collaboration form in the EHB in the future.

### 3.8. **Intensity of TA**

This field is required of all Programs for Activities with the Core Function of Technical Assistance. Options (select one):

- One time brief (single)
- One time extended (multi day contact provided one time)
- On-going infrequent (less than 3 contacts per year)
- On-going frequent (more than 3 contacts per year)

### 3.9. **Section Topic of TA/Collaboration or Continuing Education**

This is a new section, which contains 2 fields and is required of MCHB Training Programs (LENDs, LEAHs, PPCs, DBPs) for Activities with the Core Function of Continuing Education/Training or Technical Assistance.

### 3.10. **Number of unduplicated individuals served**

To better clarify the data collected, for Core Functions Direct Clinical Services/Model Services and Other Direct/Model Services, field Number of individuals seen has been renamed to Number of unduplicated individuals served.

## **4. PRODUCTS DATASET**

### **4.1. Changing the Product type**

In response to requests from the network, a functionality has been added so that if a Product is accidentally added with the incorrect Product Type, then it is very easy to fix it:

- Search for the respective Product
- Click on the View button to its left
- From the New Material Type drop-down menu, select the correct Type
- Click on Save As just beneath the drop-down menu
- The Product form opens up with the appropriate fields for the newly selected Product Type. All fields that applied to the initial Product Type as well are pre-filled with data previously entered. Complete all the required fields for the current Product Type and save the record.
- Search the original Product, with the incorrect Product Type, and delete it – this does not happen automatically.

### **4.2. Report title change**

To match the title of the form in the EHB, the Standard Report under LEND, LEAH, PPC, DBP has been renamed from PM 62: Publications to Products, Publications and Submissions Data Collection Form, Part 1.

## **5. DIRECTORY DATASET**

### **5.1. Respiratory Therapy added to the list of options for Discipline Coordinators**

It can now be selected like all other Disciplines in the Discipline Coordinators field.

### **5.2. Primary Discipline now automatically selected under Discipline(s) also**

Faculty and Staff do not need to make sure to select the same discipline for both Primary Discipline and Discipline(s) because logic has been added so that the choice for Primary Discipline is automatically selected in the Discipline(s) list as well.

### **5.3. Subscribe to AUCDigest**

The word “staff” has been removed due to feedback that it was confusing.
