
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
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







More than half of all LTSS recipients with IDD lived with a family member in 2015

Medicaid Waiver Recipients in Family Home or Other Settings and People in Family Home who are Not Medicaid Waiver Recipients 1998





Annual Family Out-of-Pocket \$ for Disability Services and Supplies




