Cureus Channel

- **What is a Cureus Channel?**
 - Efficient, low-cost publication platform
 - Easy-to-update
 - Can effectively reflect our goals while promoting innovative clinical and academic research

Publication Process

- **How does the Peer Review work?**
 - Hand-picked editors
 - We manage all content, from submission --> publication
 - Authors invite a minimum of five peer reviewers
 - This improves constructive and critical feedback by credible peer experts
 - These reviewers do not need to be affiliated Cureus
 - At least two reviews done by Cureus reviewers to reduce bias



Steps to Publication

- **What does the path for an author submitting a manuscript look like**
 - a. Author submits manuscript
 - b. Author recommends 5 peer reviewers
 - c. Administrative check & 2 Cureus reviewers assigned
 - d. Peer review
 - e. Author revisions
 - f. Channel editor review
 - g. Cureus editor review
 - h. Approved for publication



Pricing

Any author submitting an article to our channel would **NOT** need to pay any fee. It would be free of charge to submit for publication under our channel after we pay for the overall channel.



Types of Research

- **What types of research are published under Cureus?**
 - Case Reports, Tech Reports, Original Research, Review Articles, and Editorials
 - Editorials are restricted to authors with "credibility", where at least one author must be previously published in a peer reviewed journal
