Do you meet with faculty one on one?

-yes, they do 3 times per year-Michelle from Miami

Some centers have faculty send CVs once per quarter to get data. Sometimes they use different strategies.

-It can be time consuming but efficient

Some centers provide printouts of their records to refresh staff memory.

Different leadership uses NIRs differently- they determine what data is a priority to enter into NIRS.

Other centers use Pub Med search of faculty and they contact the University to see what classes the faculty has taught for that semester.

How do you get data from other faculty?

-You could do a printout with faculty names and what they have done

At the University of New Mexico- they start with the accounting department and look at project codes

-each division director chooses the funding account

-For staff/faculty activities, staff enter their own data but, Anthony vets it first.

Some centers use SurveyMonkey to get data for Technical Assistance, Consumer Satisfaction and Evaluation Data

You do not need a lot of numbers to capture your work in NIRS

LENDs care more about the number of participants. UCEDDS cares more about the number of hours

Some centers do NIRS training with new faculty/staff
