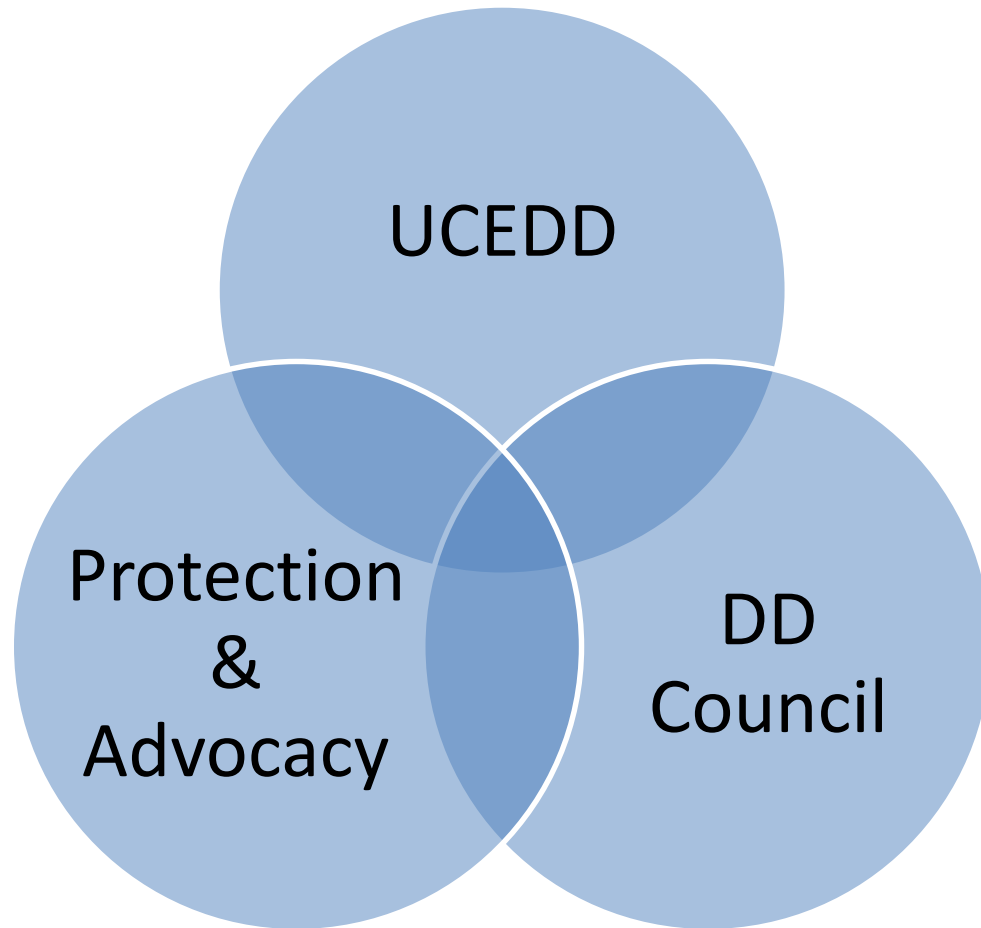


History and Context

- Several iterations, now the [DD Act of 2000](#)

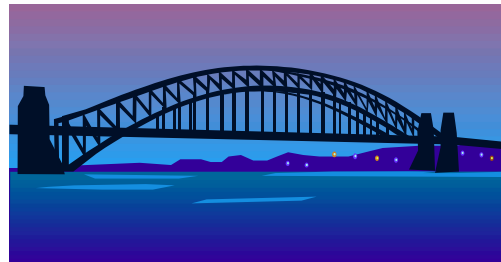


DD Network Partners

- Interdisciplinary University-based Center
- Liaison with University Schools and Departments to infuse disability studies and perspectives into multiple disciplines



- Bridge between University and community with evidence-based practice
- Advance knowledge in the field and inform local, state, national policy

4. Information Dissemination

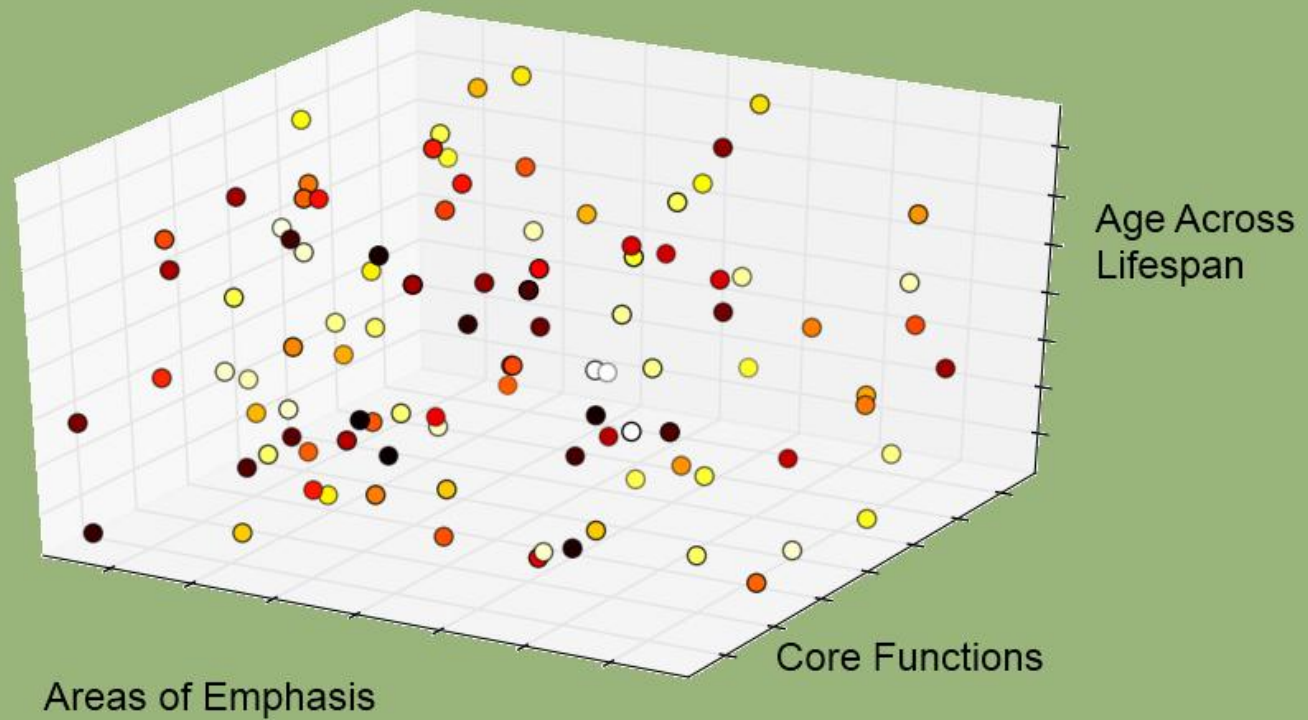
Areas of Emphasis
