In May 2011, an interdisciplinary work group began collecting and creating a series of resources designed to introduce MCH trainees to the Life Course Framework. This work group is supported by the Association of University Centers on Disabilities (AUCD) through a Cooperative Agreement with MCHB, Grant #UA5MC11068.

The interdisciplinary group is composed of representatives from the following MCHB-funded training programs: **Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and Related Disabilities (LEND) Programs; Pediatric Pulmonary Centers (PPC); Nutrition Centers; Schools of Public Health; and Leadership Education in Adolescent Health (LEAH) programs.**

The following resources have been developed (or are in the final stages of development):

- An on-line health equity quiz;
- A collection of slides on health equity, social determinants of health and Life Course;
- A glossary of Life Course terms and concepts;
- A set of case studies (and discussion topics including questions related to cultural and linguistic considerations);
- A list of additional resources for further study of Life Course;
- A webinar library of Life Course presentations.
