- CONCLUSION
 - need more data
 - more relationships



Current IPSE students as LEND trainees

- EXCEL Georgia Tech has had 4 students in GaLEND
- Students receive credits towards their certificate
- GaLEND is counted as an internship for students with an interest in advocacy, leadership and disability



IPSE Alumni as LEND Faculty & Lecturers

- LEND trainees have opportunities to shadow staff and peer mentors (receive LEND credit)
- LEND trainees learn about IPSE as an innovation when we discuss educational transition (IPSE Panel)
- 2 IPSE alumni have served as advocacy faculty in GaLEND

Iowa LEND & UI REACH

- Clinical internships for UI Reach students interested in healthcare.
- Policy partnership



Iowa LEND/REACH Policy Partnerships

- Develop joint state and federal disability priorities
- Partner on federal policy including traveling to Washington, D.C. to meet with legislators
- Partner on state policy including traveling to the Iowa State Capitol to discuss disability priorities
