 - ✓ Intermediate Outcome Measures



UCEDD Annual Report

UCEDD Annual Report Template, Definitions, FAQ, X-Walk

- Part 1: Work Plan Progress Report
 - 1.a. Detailed Work Plan Progress Report
 - 1.b. Summary of Evaluation Results
- Part 2: Measures of Improvement and Consumer Satisfaction
 - Redefined Core Functions
 - Initial Outcome Measure
- Most data points collected in NIRS, some to be entered directly in the Annual Report
 - See handout UCEDD Logic Model and Data Points in NIRS



UCEDD Annual Report

Timeline for UCEDD Annual Report Implementation:

- 2013 Annual Report to be deployed in May 2013
 - Webinar will be hosted immediately upon implementation of new report
 - UCEDD Annual Report Guidebook will be updated
- Annual Report webinar to be hosted in January 2013 to address any outstanding questions about the 2012 UCEDD Logic Model and 2013 UCEDD Annual Report

* New question “Was this training conducted outside the UCEDD?” to be added to Interdisciplinary Pre-service Preparation form, only for UCEDD Programs, by February 2013.

FY 2013 NIRS Changes

Compendium of FY 2013 NIRS Changes

Main changes made with the FY 2013 iteration:

- Core Functions – customized Activity forms per Core Function and Program Type
 - ✓ Types and Numbers of Participants
 - ✓ Initial Outcome Measure
 - ✓ Topic of Continuing Education/Technical Assistance for MCHB Programs
 - ✓ Unnecessary fields hidden from form for ease of data entry
- Trainee form – new section on Primary Language



FY 2013 NIRS Changes

NIRS Updates Implemented During FY 2013:

- Customer Satisfaction Measure – no longer required
- Initial Outcome Measure – automatically Not Applicable for Continuing Education Activities
- Primary Target Audience added to TA form for MCHB Programs
- Continuing Education question branched out:

UCEDD only Activities	MCHB only Activities	UCEDD and LEND Activities

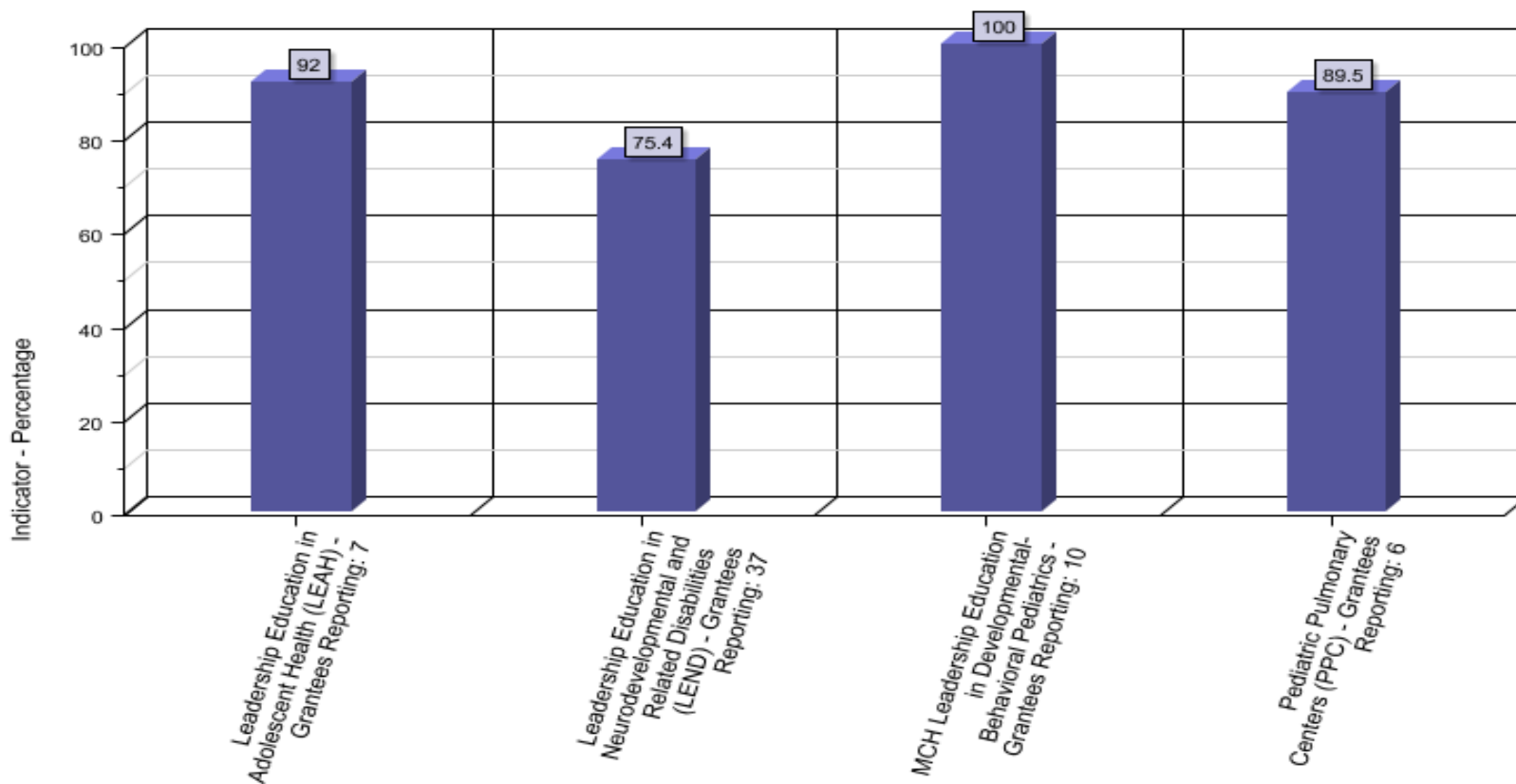
MCH Training Performance Measures

- PM07, The degree to which MCHB-funded programs ensure family, youth, and consumer participation in program and policy activities
- PM08, The percentage of graduates of MCHB long-term training programs that demonstrate field leadership after graduation
- PM09, The percentage of participants in MCHB long-term training programs who are from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups
- PM10, The degree to which MCHB-funded programs have incorporated cultural and linguistic competence elements into their policies, guidelines, contracts, and training

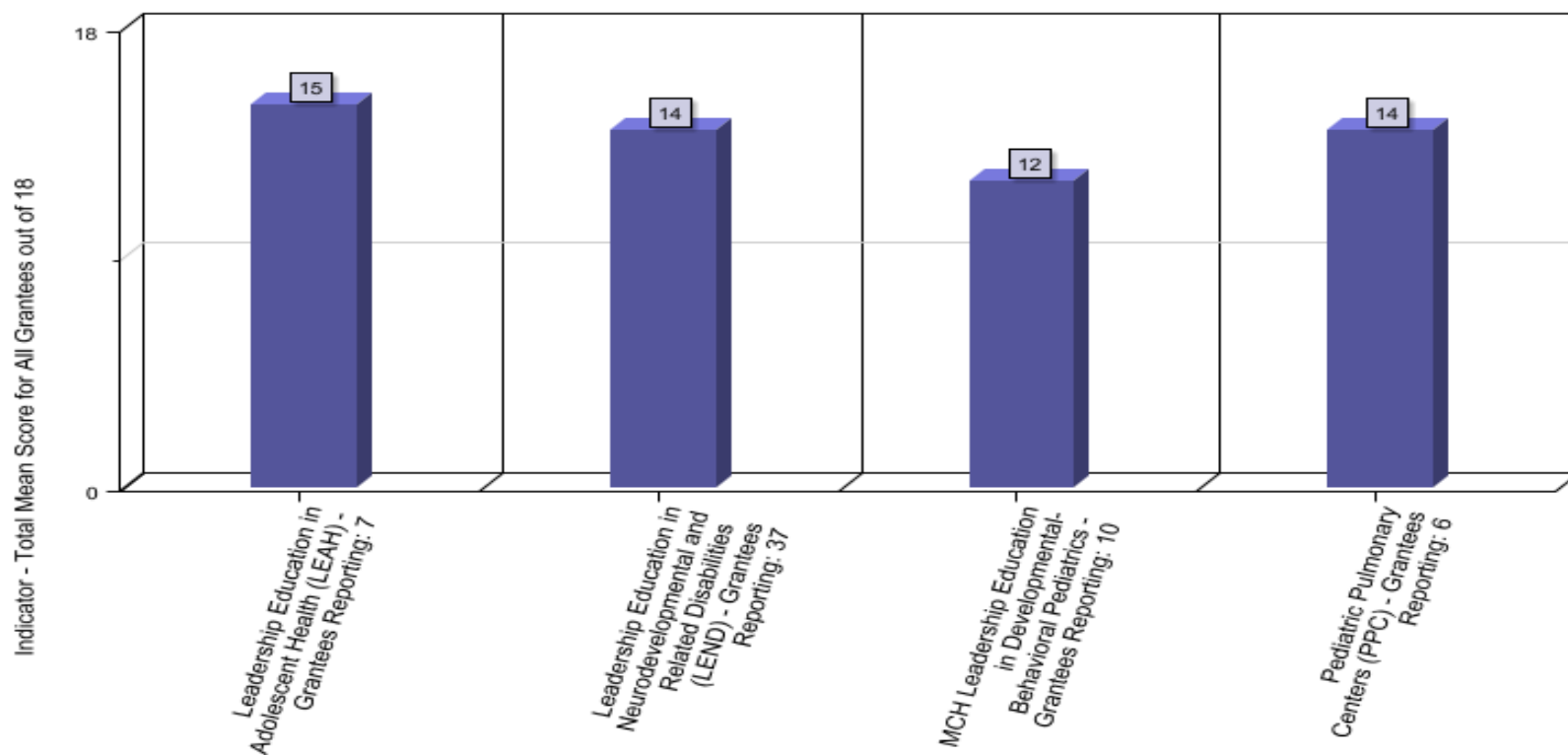
MCH Training Performance Measures

- PM59, The degree to which a training program collaborates with State Title V agencies, other MCH or MCH-related programs
- PM84, The percent of long-term training graduates who are engaged in work related to MCH populations
(New in 2010)
- PM85, The degree to which MCH long term training grantees engage in policy development, implementation, and evaluation (New in 2010)

MCH Training Performance Measures

- PPM 58: The percentage of PPC faculty who demonstrate field leadership in the areas of academic, clinical, public health/policy, and advocacy. (PPC)
- PM60, The percent of long-term trainees who, at 1, 5 and 10 years post training, work in an interdisciplinary manner to serve the MCH population (LEND, LEAH, PPC)
- PM63, The degree to which LEND programs incorporate medical home concepts into their curricula/training (LEND)
- PM64, The degree to which the LEAH program incorporates adolescents and parents from diverse ethnic and cultural backgrounds as advisors and participants in program activities. (LEAH)
- PPM 86: The degree to which medium term trainees report an increase in knowledge and skills upon completion of PPC training. (PPC)

Timeline for Performance Reporting

- Annually
- Occurs after completion of budget period
- 120 days from release of next budget year's Notice of Award
- Submission in DGIS after NIRS data upload
- Deadline is in the October-November timeframe
