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





Confirmed ASD cases among children aged 8 years (n=251), Arkansas Autism Project 2002




□ Confirmed ASD Cases

Arkansas Act 1198 of 2007 (Rep. Johnson)

- Medicaid waiver for intensive early intervention for children (3-10 yrs) diagnosed with PDD
- Not yet funded
