Autism CARES Module

- The Autism Collaboration, Accountability, Research, Education and Support Act (Autism CARES) is the primary source of federal funding for autism research, services, training, and monitoring.
 - Examples of Autism CARES grantees: ITAC, LEND programs, DBP programs
- Through the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) and specific accountability criteria outlined in the Autism CARES Act, data collection and analysis for the CARESfunded training programs is vitally important to MCHB for monitoring grant recipients' progress and assessing investments related to training.
- A specific NIRS module has been developed for LEND and DBP programs to collect/report
 on their specific autism specific-related training and clinical activities under the Autism
 CARES Act (i.e. "CARES module"). The data is collected annually from this module and is
 sent to MCHB.



Autism CARES Module Timeline

LENDs and DBPs complete the Autism CARES Module on an annual basis.

June 11th – June 15th

Autism Cares Module open for data entry


July 15th – July 31st

Deadline for data entry into the Autism CARES Module



Autism CARES Evaluation: Upcoming Updates


A new paragraph will be added to the introduction text at the top of the Autism CARES Module in NIRS:



"Some terminology in the CARES Module and Data Dictionary has been slightly updated by ITAC to reduce ableist language (e.g., AS/DD will replace ASD/DD to remove the abbreviation for the disorder). The data collected and reported by programs remains unchanged, and the definitions remain unchanged."

The LEND Program Quality Improvement (LPQI) Network





Goal of LPQI Network

Helps individual LEND training programs improve the **quality of LEND training** in core competencies (family-professional partnership, interdisciplinary teams, advocacy/policy) by:

- 1) creating standardized measurement tools
- 2) developing a voluntary, inter-institutional database
- 3) providing program-level feedback to programs that choose to participate
- identifying programs that demonstrate changes consistent with best practices



LPQI Network

- Web-based dashboard that provides data on your LEND program compared to national benchmarks
- Linked to NIRS (minimal data entry)
- Bi-monthly technical assistance calls
- Suite of online tools/FAQs/etc.
 - Tutorials on how to implement, use dashboard, etc.
 - Trainee self-report measures
 - Faculty observation measures
 - Training materials for faculty observation measure

Measurement Tools

Participating LEND Programs (32+) use two common tools:

Trainee Self-Report CCM (Core Competency Measure)	Faculty Observation I-FOR (Interdisciplinary/Family-Centered Care Observation Rubric)
administered at baseline and completion of program year	administered 1/3 of the way through program year and at completion of program year

- LPQI dashboard automatically analyzes data from participating LEND programs to determine change in baseline for each competency across both measures.
- Programs have access to reports on their own performance & the ability to compare outcomes with aggregate national data.




Figure 1: Percent Change in Trainee and Faculty Scores by Competency Domain



Data Cleaning Tips for Reportable Data

TRAINEES

- 1. Standard Report: Trainee Data Entry Errors
- Compare the number of current Trainees exported with the number of Trainees in the NIRS Trainee dataset > Manage Long/med term trainees
 - Example: for –AAA Test Center, there are 6 exported but 7 trainees listed in NIRS
- Compare the number of Former Trainees exported with the number of Trainees in the Trainee dataset > Standard Report > under LEND, LEAH, PPC, DBP > Long Term Survey Info (2018+)

PRODUCTS

- 1. Standard Report: Product Data Entry Errors
- 2. <u>Tips Sheet Data Cleaning in the Products</u> dataset

Export/Import NIRS Data Tools






Import and Export

Import and **export** of data share a semantic analogy with copying and pasting -- in that sets of data are copied from one application and pasted into another.


The concept of those tools (Export and Import) is straightforward: get data in and out of NIRS. Both tools are located under the Admin tab. Only data coordinators with Admin access can use those tools.






Export Tool

Steps to get data out of NIRS








How to Read Data in the .CSV Files

The first column includes two essential links:

NIRS Table and Field Definitions: this is the data dictionary of the NIRS database. It
includes a list of all tables with listed field datatypes. We are transparent in our approach, so
we are giving you all information about database architecture.

Code Table Definitions: that table displays the relationship between the online display value and the value entered in the database.

Benefits of the Import Tool

Data Import Tool lets you upload data in bulk from external sources into NIRS. The Import tool is designed to decrease the time spent on data entry in NIRS.

Data can be imported into four datasets:

- Projects
- Activities
- Products
- Trainees (Main + Annual records)


We will be covering two scenarios for the Import Tool:

- 1. Transferring multiple records from the previous FY/PE year into a new one
- 2. Collecting data in an excel spreadsheet and importing it into NIRS.




