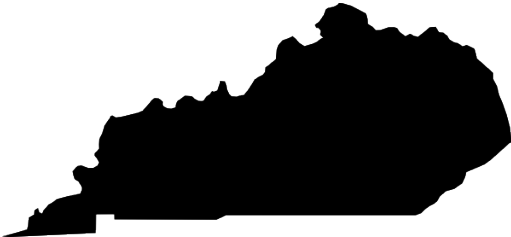


## AUCD Centers Serving Kentucky

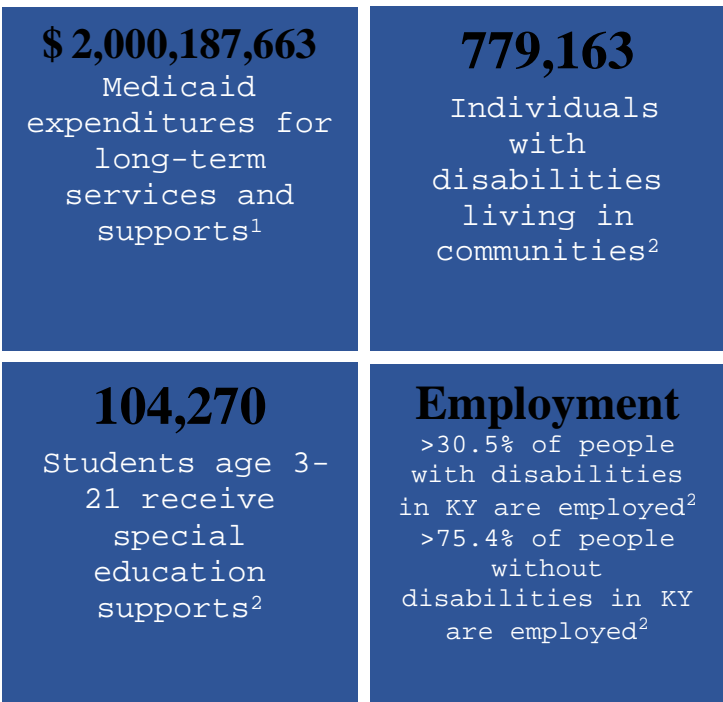
