Explanation of Columns:

Duals Demos: "X" marks the states that were one of the 26 states to receive a \$1 million grant from CMS to design a demonstration to integrate care and align financing for dually eligible Medicare-Medicaid enrollees, as of June 2012. The demonstration projects' start dates range between now and mid-2014. Two states have withdrawn applications

Rebalancing: States that have adopted Money Follows the Person legislation are marked with MFP. States approved by CMS to adopt the Community First Choice Option or Balancing Incentive Program are marked with CFC or BIP, respectively.

Expansion: Currently 27 states will expand (Y), 15 will not expand (N), 3 are leaning toward no (L/N), 1 is leaning toward yes (L/Y) and 5 are undecided.

Exchange: States have chosen to run own exchange have done so through legislative action (State Run (L)), or through executive action by the state governor (State Run (E)). Others default to a federally-facilitated exchange (FFE-Default) or will run their exchange in partnership with the federal government (partnership).

Employment: "X" marks the states that have enacted employment first legislation/policies, these states are marked with an "X".
