

Rapid Responses to Information Requests

AUCD is often asked by AIDD for information regarding UCEDD network activities. These requests align with federal efforts and/or partnerships, and require a rapid response that may be as short as a couple of hours. This information highlights efforts across the UCEDD network in key topic areas. For such requests, AUCD does not have the time necessary to poll the network via email; instead, we search in the NIRS datasets for project, activity and product record, along with accompanying UCEDD staff or faculty contact information. The UCEDD Directory is also utilized to identify experts in topic areas. For this reason, it is quite helpful for UCEDDs to maintain updated information in NIRS and the Directory.
