AUCD Board Updates

- Upcoming Board of Director calls

- Current Board discussion:
 - Approach to private sector fundraising
 - Meeting network needs in international work
 - Ensuring focus on IDD while also working cross-disability

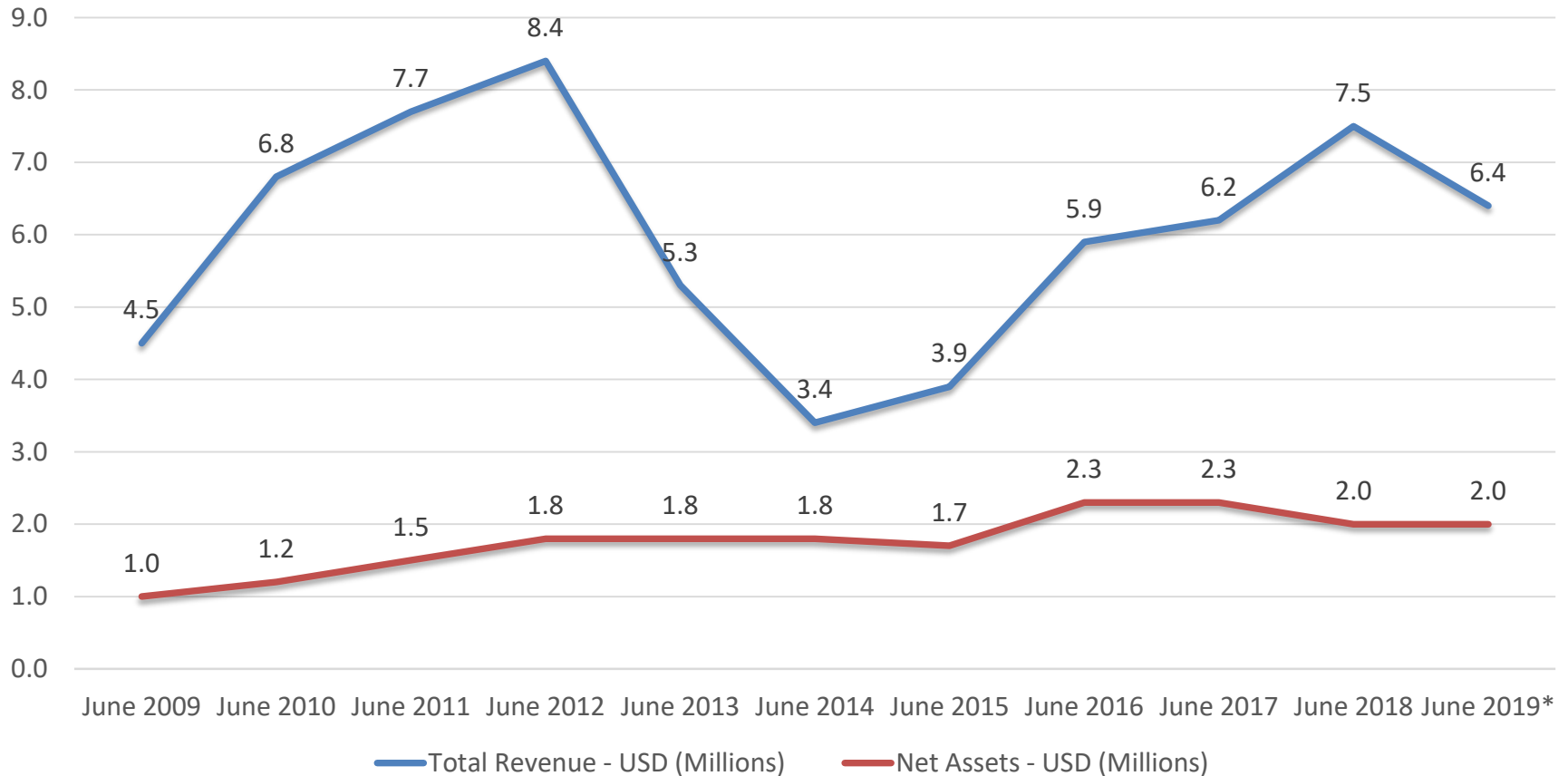


- Upcoming bylaws change requests
 - Board size changed from 19 to 16, with option for up to 20
 - Adding a voting role for emerging leader/early career professional
 - Create consistency with how everyone comes on to the Board and is eligible for Board Officer roles



- Board voted for dues increase (2%) effective new fiscal year - July 1
 - First increase since 2016
 - Costs of doing business has increased
 - UCEDD core grants went up in the budget bill from \$547,000 to \$570,000.

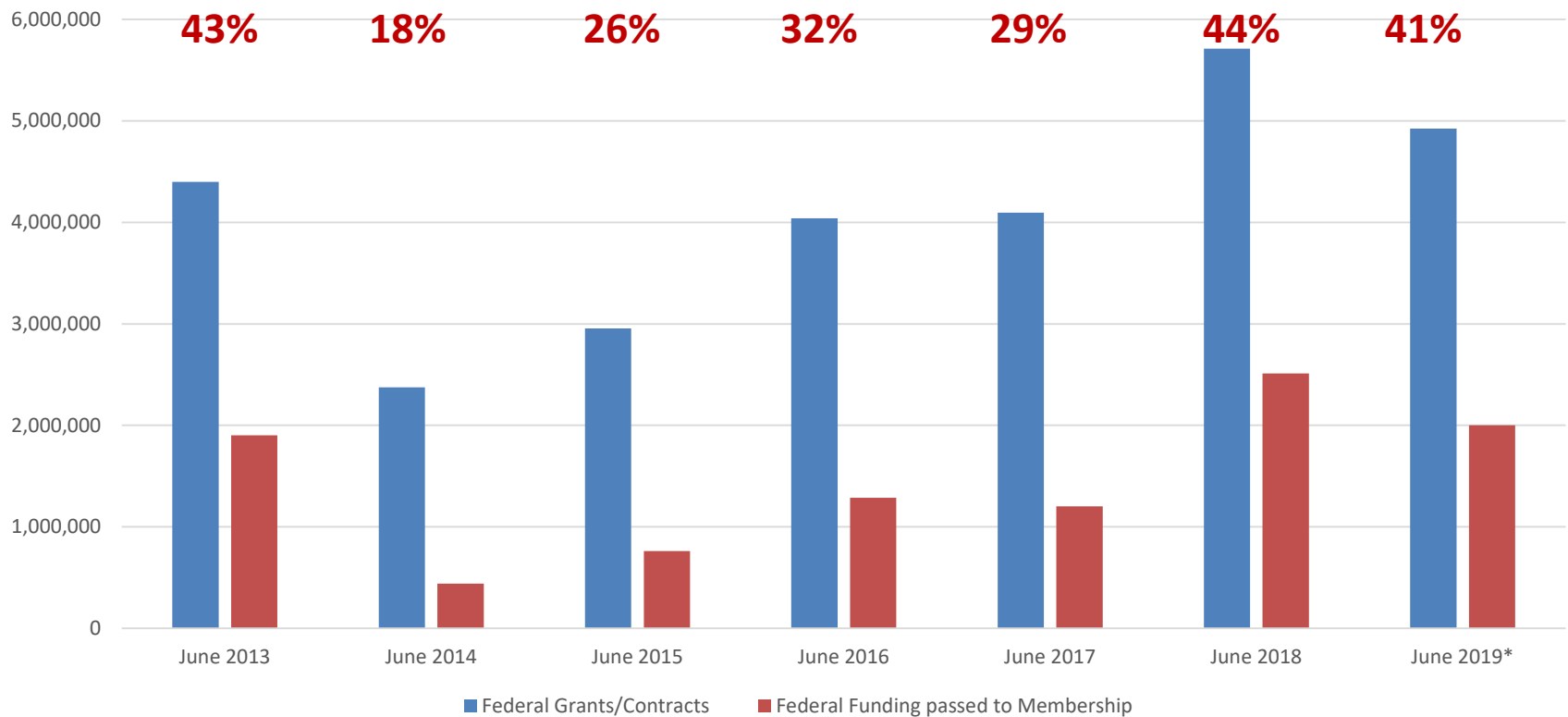
Multi-Year Net Assets Results (In Millions of USD)

*Adjusted Budget Projections for 2019

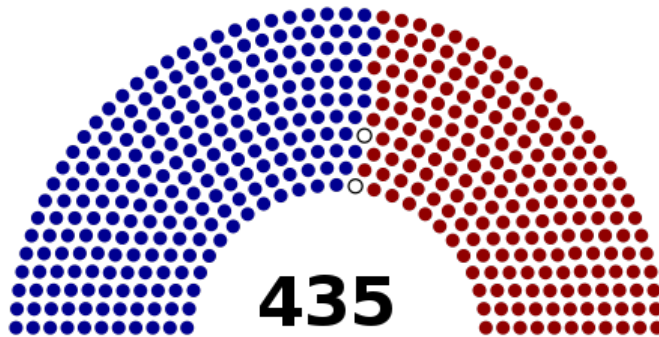


AUCD Policy Updates

- Unconventional Presidential Administration
- Race for 2020
 - Slows things down; votes are tied to campaigns

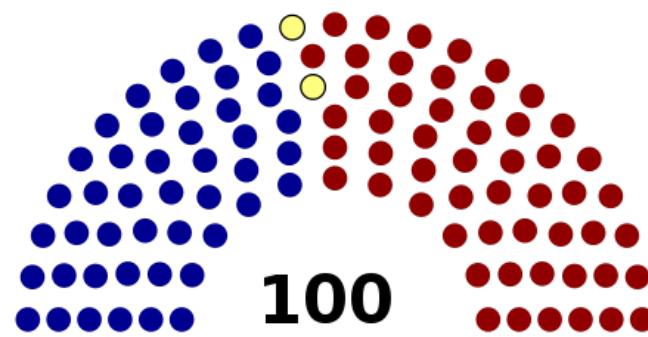
House of Representatives

- H&S agree on 13 annual appropriations bills – Sept.
- Fiscal year begins Oct. 1

- President's Budget Released March 11th
- Full details released on March 18th
- Appropriations under way
 - Increased ask for LEND/UCEDD
 - Maintain PNS
 - House request/"Dear Colleagues" letters process starting
 - Senate request/"Dear Colleagues" letter process starting

- The Autism CARES Act
 - has expanded research and coordination
 - increased public awareness and surveillance
 - expanded interdisciplinary health professional training, including LENDsto identify and support people with Autism and their families
- will sunset (expire) in September 2019 without a successful reauthorization.
- Bills to reauthorize the Act have been introduced and need co-sponsors ([HR. 1058](#), [S. 427](#))
