What's New in NIRS 2.0

Overview of New Functionalities

- Center Dashboard landing page
 - Visualization of financial information (restricted access based on security level)
 - Resource Library (center-specific list of resources)
 - My Notes (user to-do list)
- Trainee data set: Quick Email tool (email functionality to be used by Directors and Data Coordinators to communicate with current trainees)
- Separation of Standard and Custom Reports. Custom Report is now a stand-alone tool.



What's New in NIRS 2.0

Overview of Enhancements

- Responsive layout
- Anchored horizontal menu
- New code compliant with ColdFusion 2016 (server upgrade is planned in September)
- HTML5
- Unique color identifying each dataset
- Implemented for all datasets:
 - Use of new management tool (displayed as 3-dot icon)
 - Sub-menu displayed in two-column format
 - Paging module
 - Option to display selected number of records per page
 - Search datasets over multiple years made available directly on a dataset list page
 - Revised list of columns displaying item information in each dataset
