The challenge of designing and offering quality professional development content that is evidence-based and meets the diverse needs of early intervention providers is a unique opportunity. In Virginia, there are over 1,300 early intervention providers representing more than 20 professional disciplines. Providers need access to "just in time" information and resources to guide their practice and intervention.

Landing Pads



• 17% of the visitors access the site to download one of the 15 landing pads.


Videos
