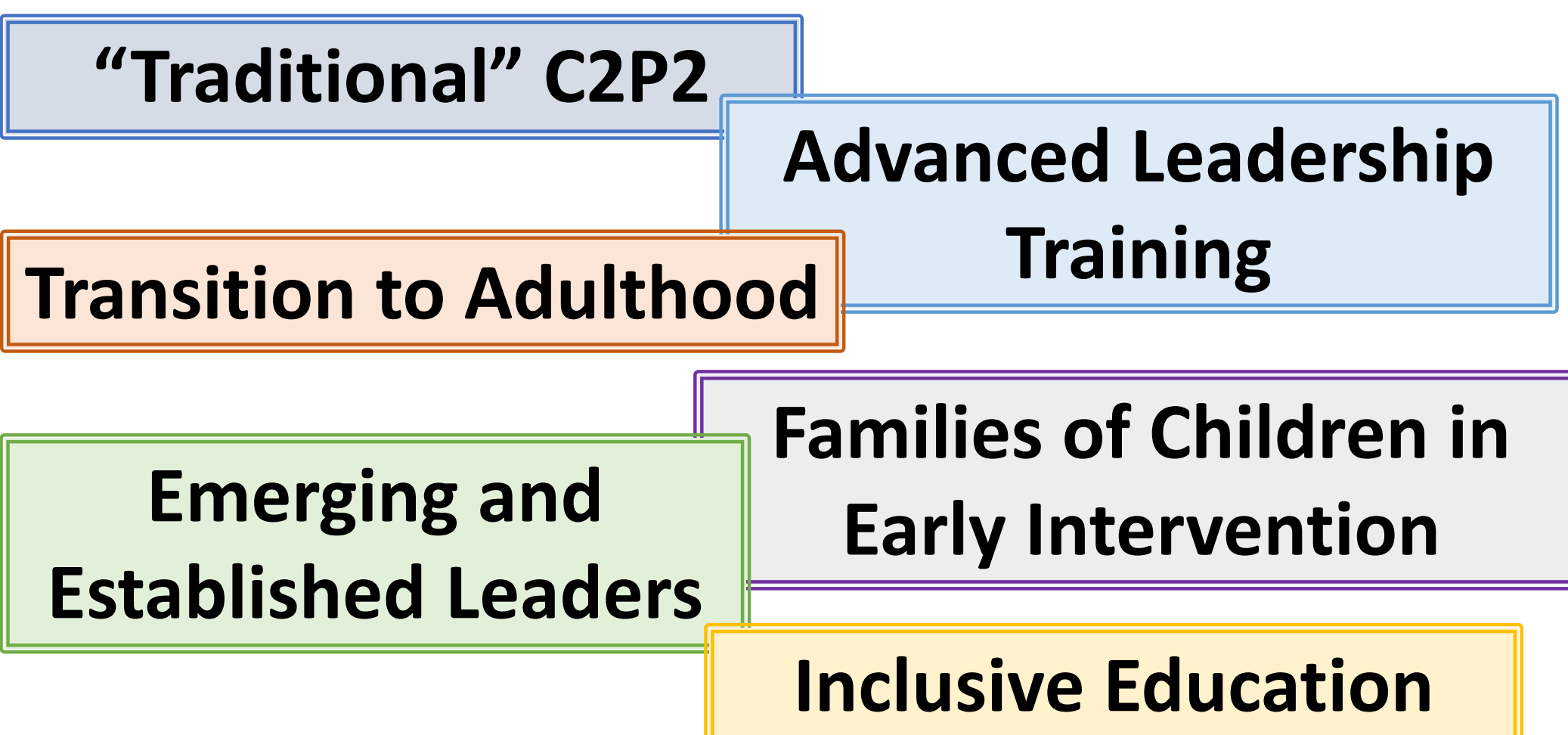
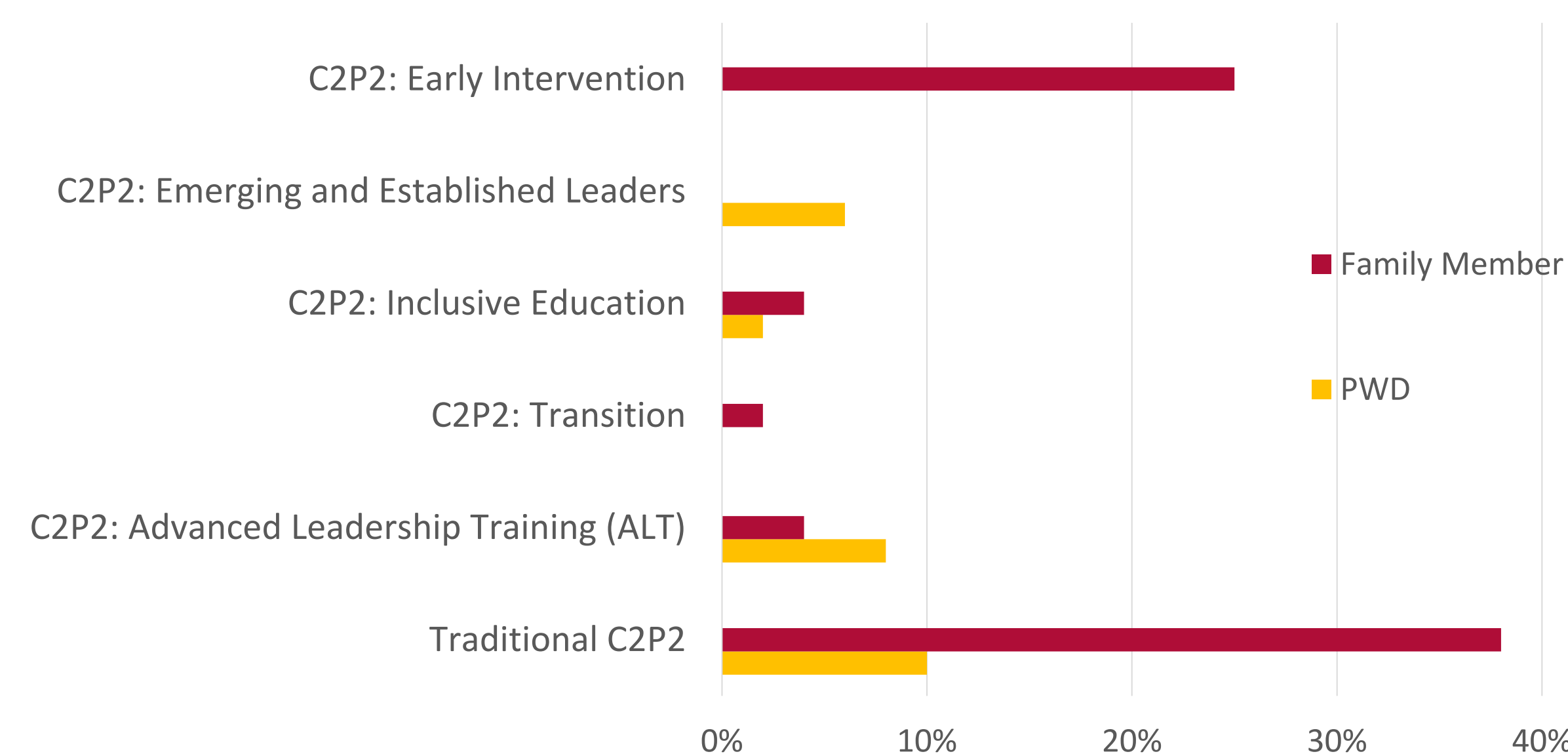

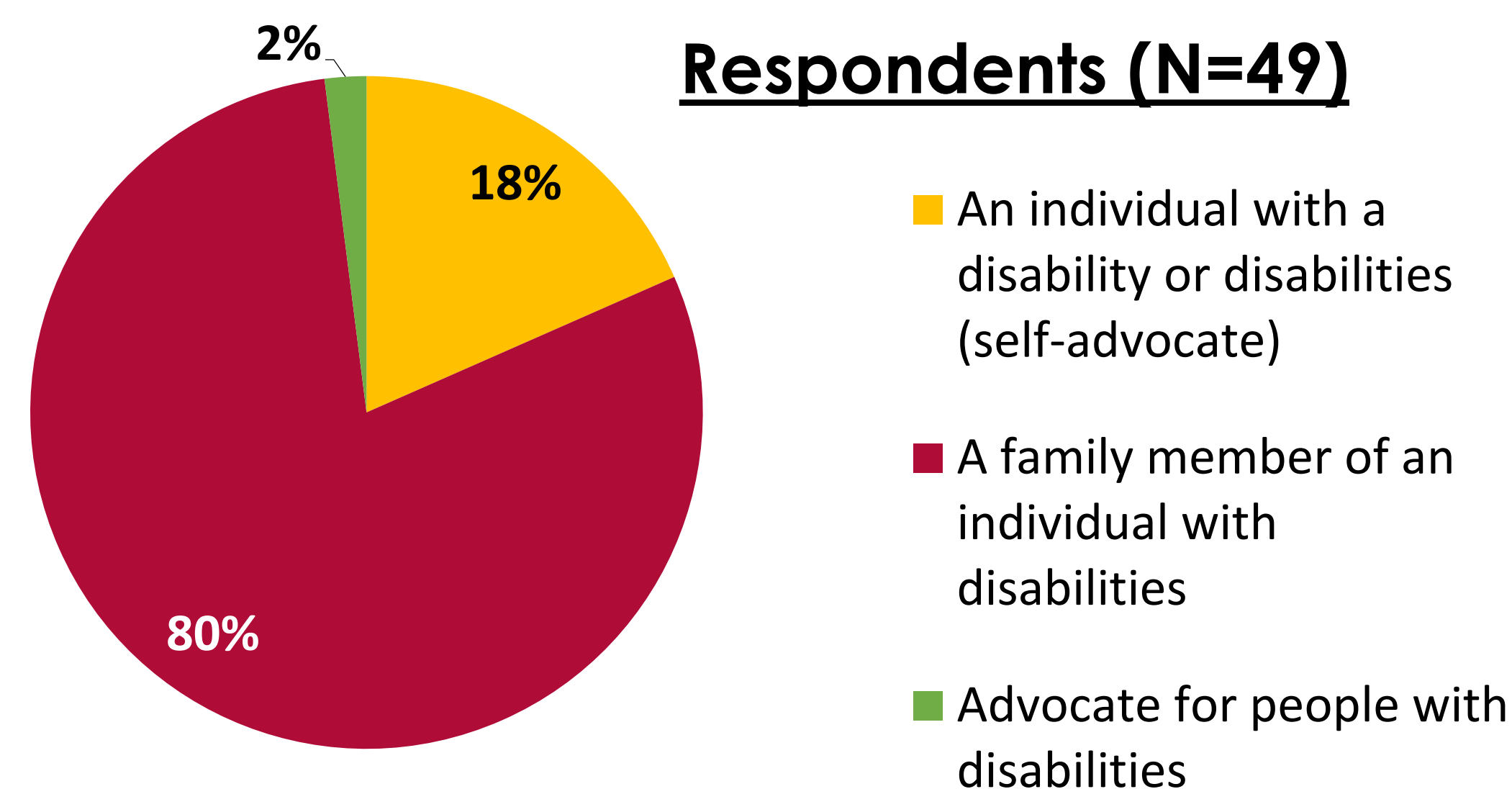
Survey Respondents' C2P2 Program

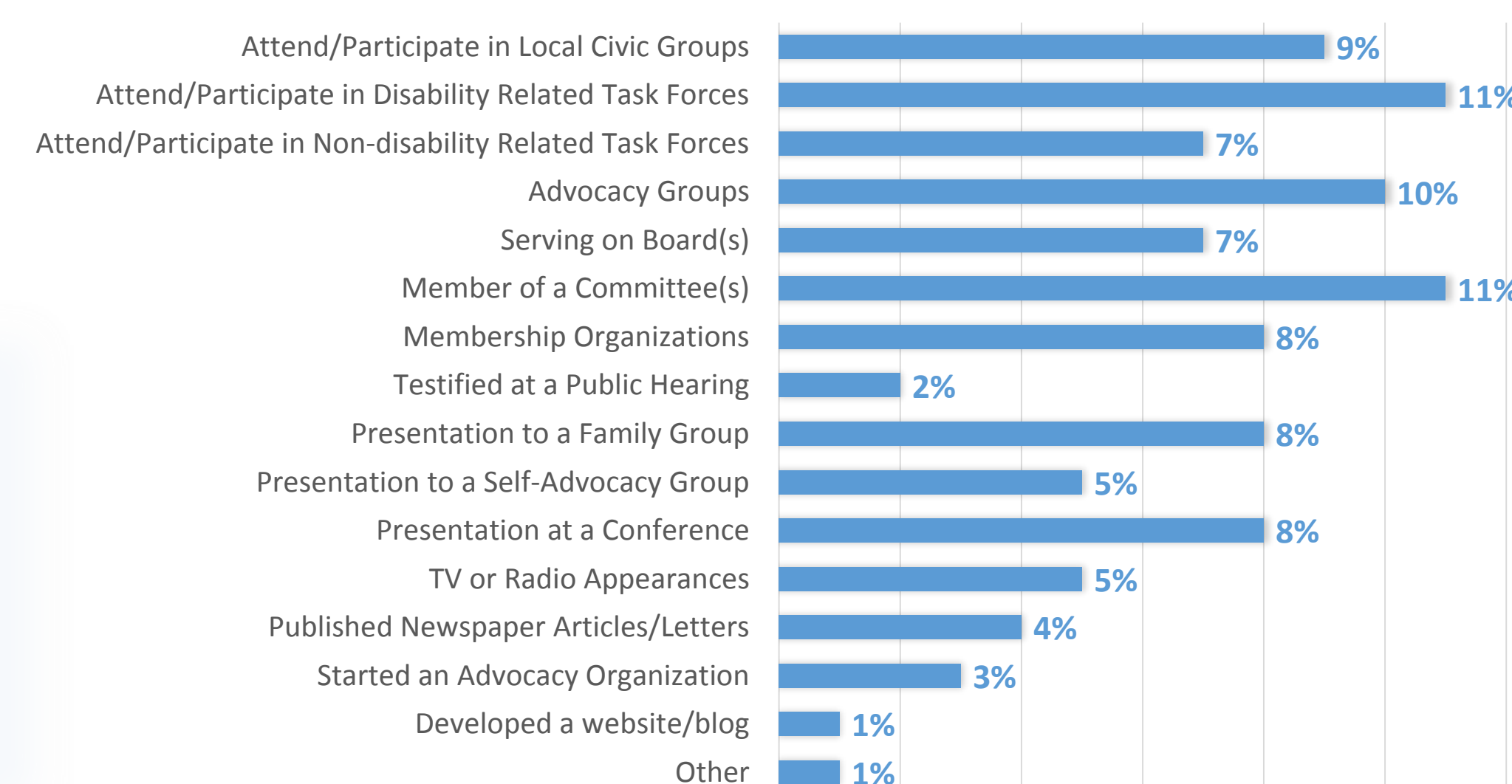

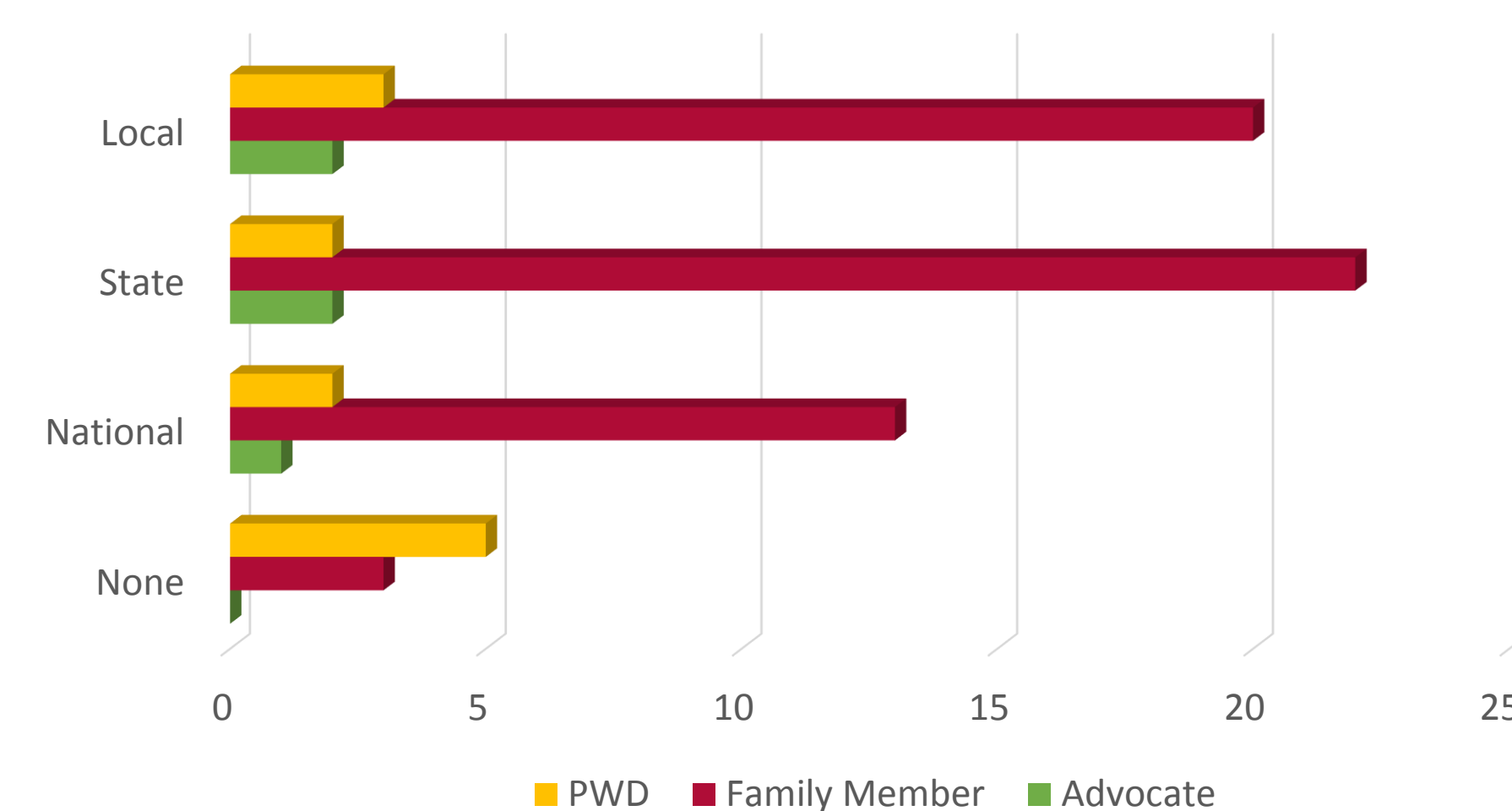

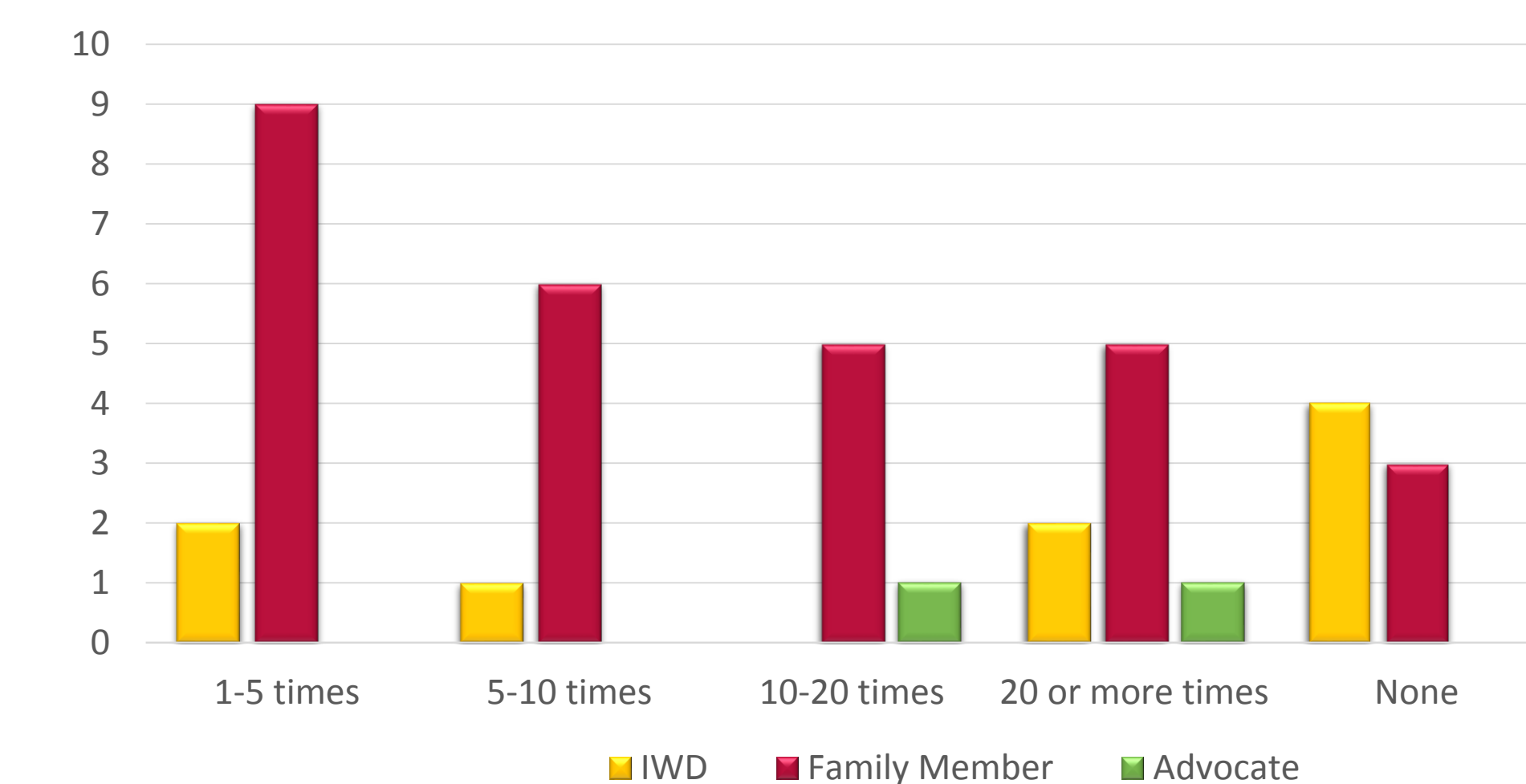

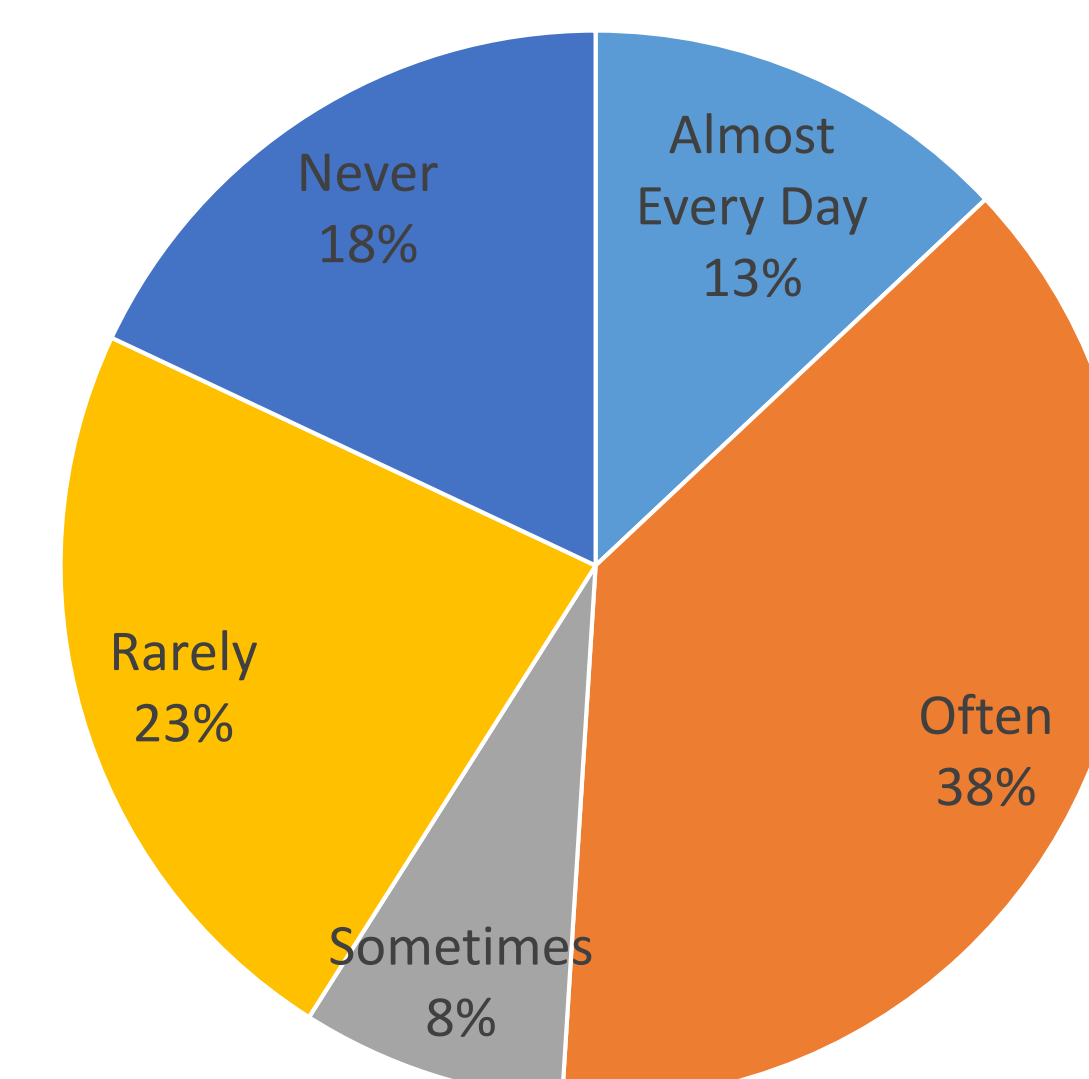
Contacting Public Officials
