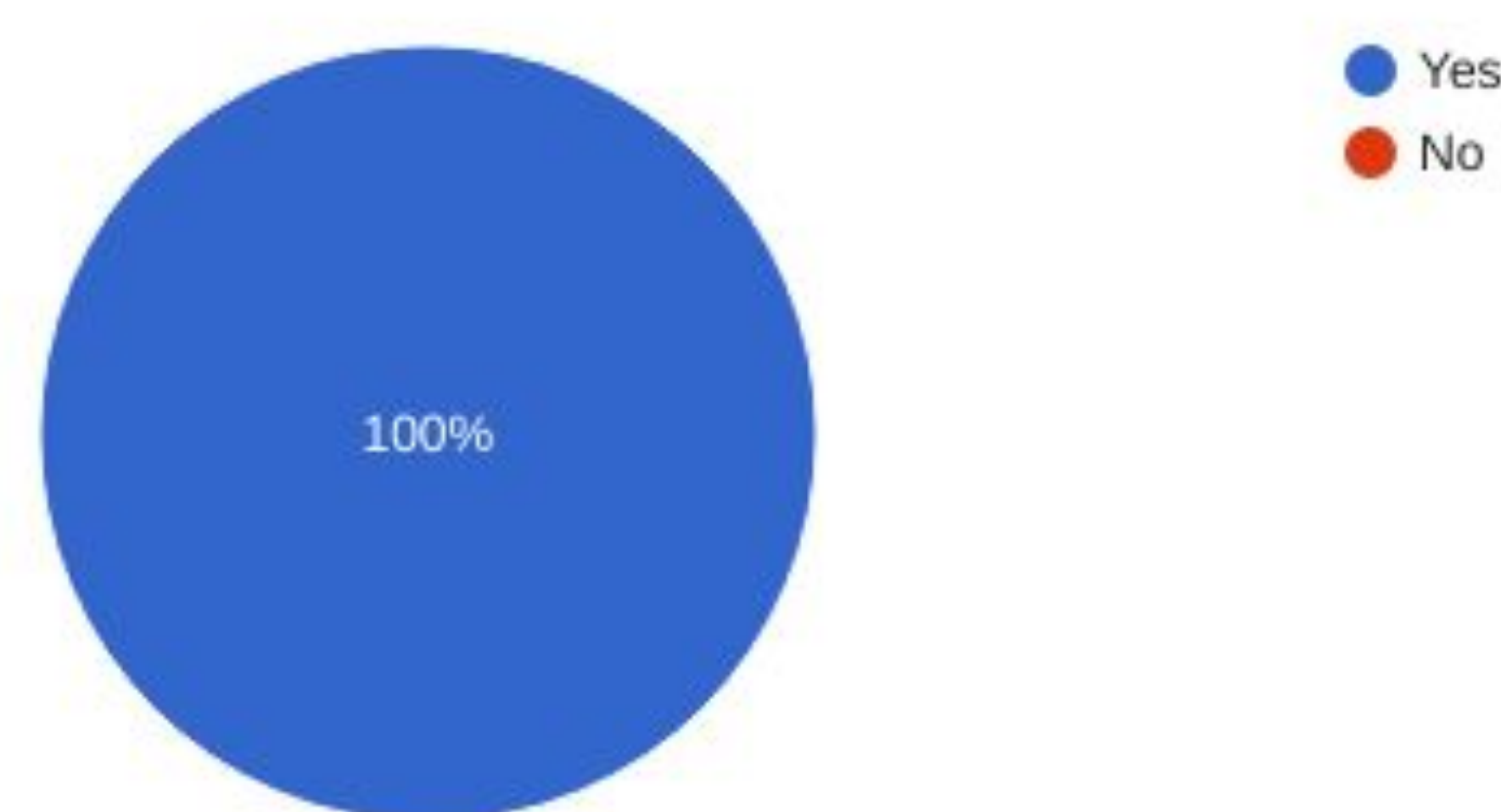
**Question:** How ready is faculty to be compliant with accessible digital content?

**Results:** High awareness of Section 508 but low preparedness and resources to comply

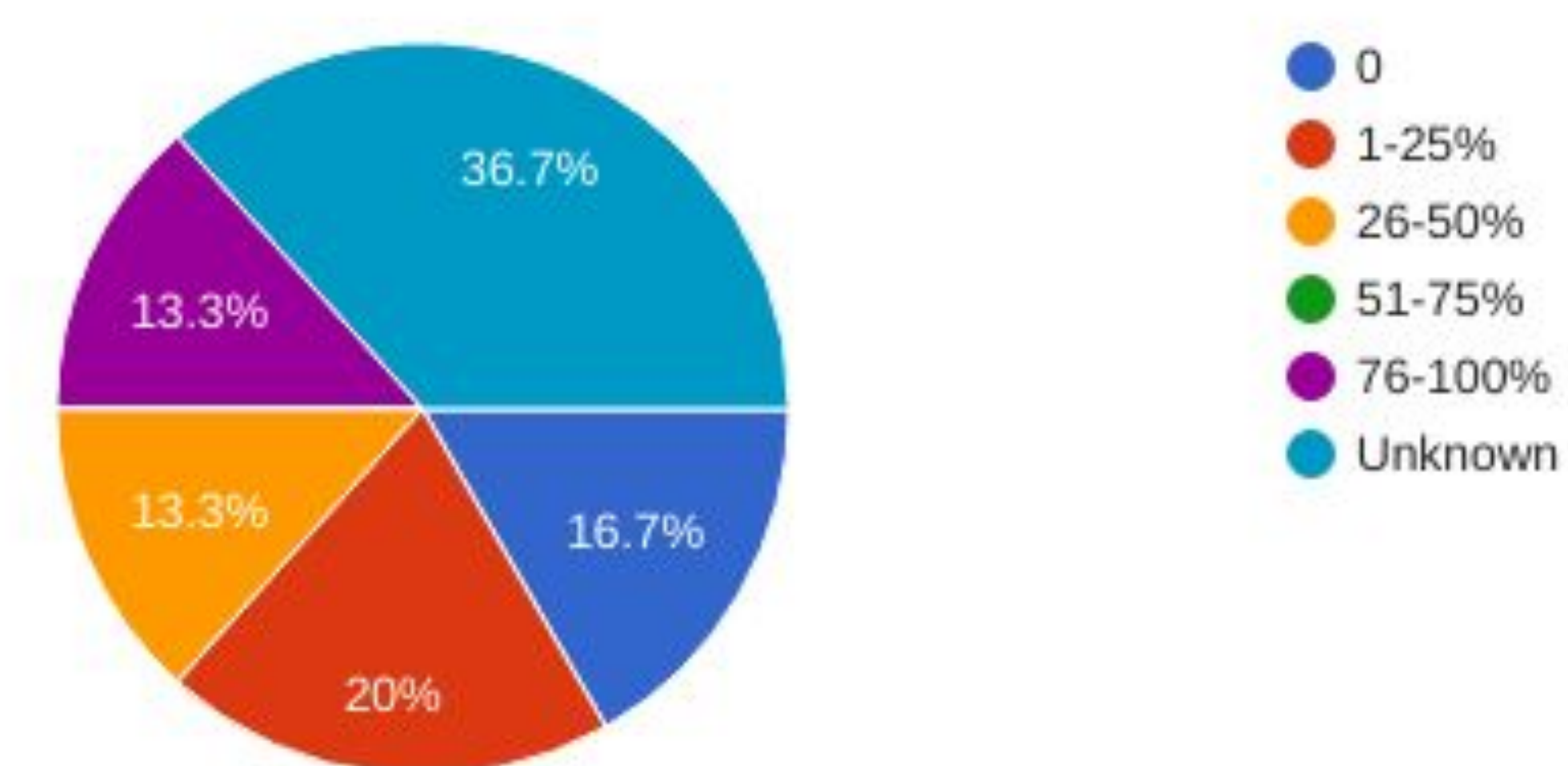
Are you familiar with the University request to have your digital content fully compliant with Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act?

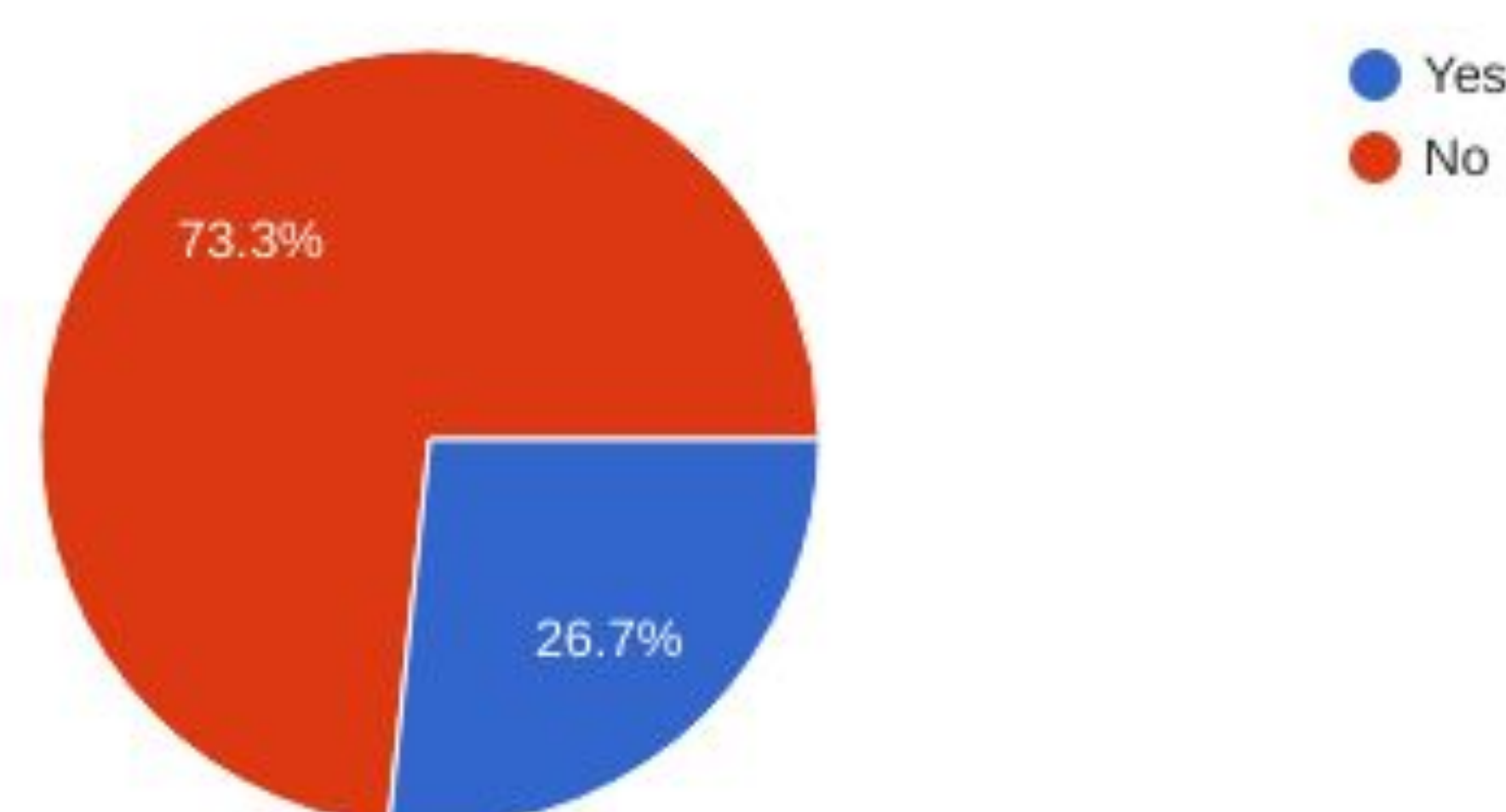
Currently, what is your estimated percentage of digital content (documents, videos, presentation slides, etc.) that ... to make it compliant with Section 508?

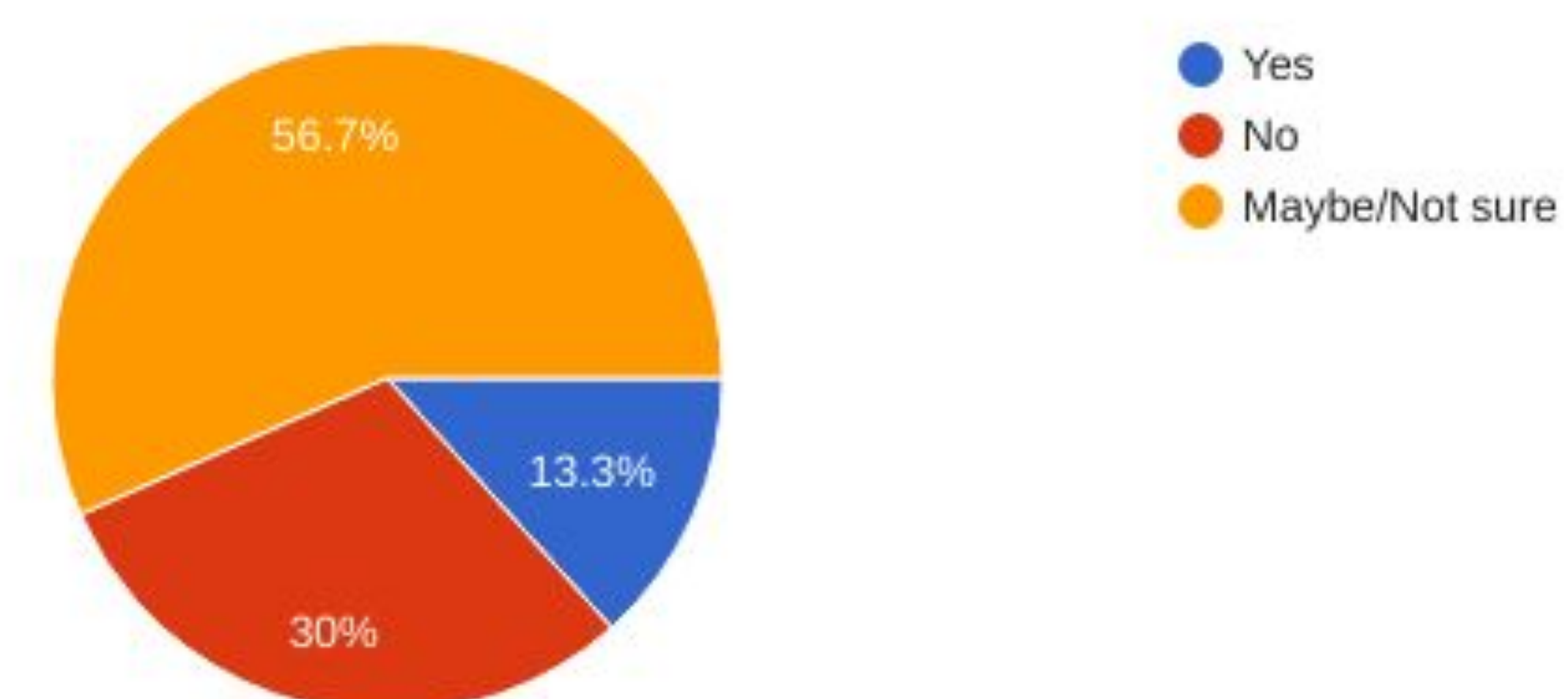
Are you familiar with the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 Level A and AA?

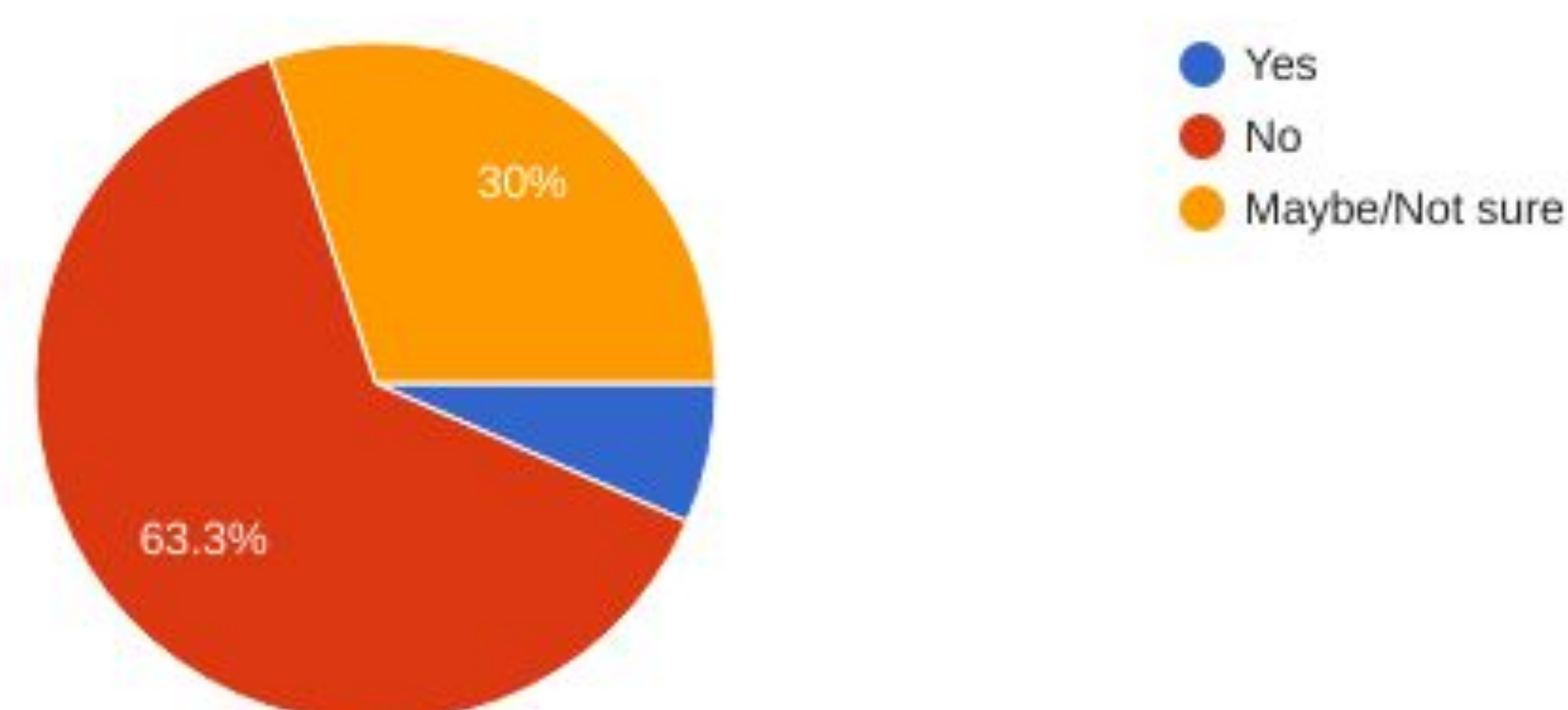
Are you able to make your future (beginning June 1, 2018) digital content compliant with Section 508 and the WCAG 2.0 Level A and AA?
