Background

- **Purpose was to gain insight into EHDI stakeholder perspectives about the effectiveness of the chapter champion activities in supporting the primary goals of the AAP EHDI program by conducting a multi-disciplinary, mixed methods evaluation of pediatricians, families of children who are deaf or hard of hearing, state EHDI coordinators, and nonphysician clinicians**

Planning & Implementation

- **Partnership with families, state EHDI programs, pediatricians in evaluation planning, dissemination, and analysis of results**
- **Evaluation implementation strategies**
 - **Provide communication accommodations**

- **Collaborate with groups who have strong and trusting relationships with the population you are targeting for your evaluation**
