Leadership Skills

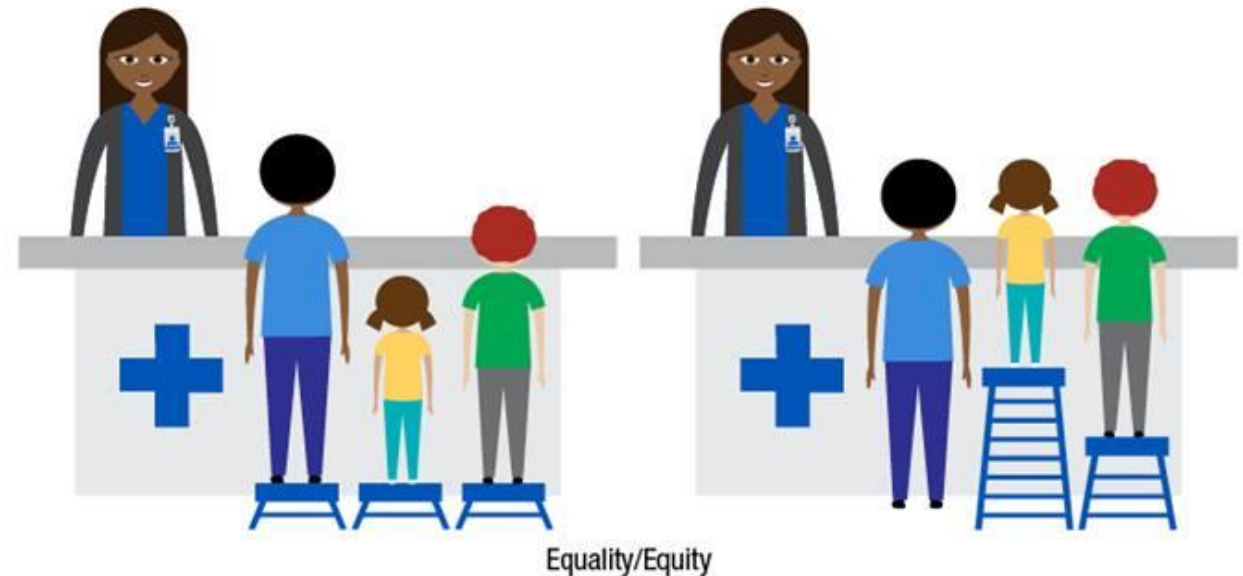


- Think of a leader you admire, or you look up to.
